

ORDER

(Date: 6th August, 2019)

1. This appeal is filed under Sec. 10 of Madhya Pradesh Niji Vyavasayik Shikshan Sanstha (Pravesh Ka Viniyaman Avam Shulk ka Nirdharan), Adhinyam, 2007 (hereinafter referred to as "Act of 2007") against the order passed by the Admission and Fee Regulatory Committee (AFRC for short) dated 10/07/2019, whereby the fee for the appellant institute was fixed at Rs.1,99,000/- per student per year for BAMS Course run by it for three academic sessions 2019-20, 2020-21 & 2021-22.
2. This appeal is filed on the ground that the AFRC has not taken into the consideration, the actual figures of expenditure incurred by the institute on salaries paid to the faculty, which resulted in lower amount of fees fixed by the AFRC. The appellant further submits that due to some mistakes, the amount shown as expenditure on salary was reduced by AFRC. During the course of hearing, the appellant explained the expenditure and the entire amount shown by the appellant as expenditure on salary is now, taken into consideration.

3. Shri Daga calculated the amount after taking the amount spent on salary as explained by the appellant and according to his calculation, the amount of fees for the institute per year per student is Rs.2,40,900/.
4. Shri Chaube, the respondent appearing on behalf of AFRC submits that since earlier, the error could not be explained which is now satisfactorily explained. The amount calculated by Shri Daga may be taken into consideration.
5. Accordingly, after taking into consideration of the submissions made by both the sides, this appeal is allowed. The amount fixed by the AFRC Rs.1,99,000/- is enhanced to Rs.2,41,000/- per year per student. (Rs.2,40,900/- rounded off to Rs. 2,41,000/-). The amount of other charges fixed by the AFRC shall remain the same.
6. With the aforesaid modifications, the appeal stands disposed off.
