Sir/Madam,

I am directed to refer to this Ministry's order of even number dated 20.06.2019, vide which, Rani Dullaiya Smriti Ayurved PG College and Hospital, Bhopal, Madhya Pradesh, was granted Conditional Permission for conducting 100 seats in UG(BAMS) Course for the academic year 2019-20 and denial of permission to conduct 09 PG courses with 45 seats namely (i) Ayurved Samhita siddhant (ii) Rachana sharir (iii) Swasthavritta (iv) Kaumarabhritya (v) Agad Tantra (vi) Panchkarma (vii) Dravyaguna (viii) Rasashastra & Bhaishajya Kalpana (ix) Shalya Tantra, for the academic session 2019-20.

- 2. Subsequently, the college has submitted the documents related to fulfilment of deficiencies conveyed earlier in respect of PG Courses. The same has been examined in terms of IMCC Post Graduate Ayurveda Regulations, 2016, and it is found that the college is fulfilling the norms for granting conditional permission for 09 PG courses with 45 seats, for the academic year 2019-20.
- 3. It has, therefore, been decided by the Central Government to grant Conditional Permission to the Rani Dullaiya Smriti Ayurved PG College and Hospital, Bhopal, Madhya Pradesh for conducting 09 PG courses with 45 seats namely (i) Ayurved Samhita siddhant (ii) Rachana sharir (iii) Swasthavritta (iv) Kaumarabhritya (v) Agad Tantra (vi) Panchkarma (vii) Dravyaguna (viii) Rasashastra & Bhaishajya Kalpana (ix) Shalya Tantra with 05 seats in each subject for the academic session 2019-20 under Section 13C/13A of the IMCC Act, 1970.

- 4. It is further informed that 15% of post graduate seats of the permitted intake capacity of 45 PG seats shall be treated as all India quota. The counseling for seats under all India quotas shall be conducted by the Central Government and counseling for the remaining 85% seats shall be conducted by the concerned Counseling Authority of that State. If any seats are not filled up in the Central Counseling, the same shall be transferred to the said Counseling Authority to admit students as per their rules/ reservation policies/norms. The permission of the college stands withdrawn if the college fails to comply with the Central counseling for all India quota or admitted thereunder.
- 5. Admissions made in violation of the above conditions will be treated as invalid and action will be initiated under IMCC Act & Regulations made thereunder.
- 6. Discrepancies, if any, may be immediately brought to the notice of CCIM and the Central Government.
- 7. The following requirements should be fulfilled by the college by 31st December, 2019 to get permission for the session 2020-21:
 - (i) all the Requirements of Minimum Standard of infrastructure and teaching & training facilities as specified in Regulation 3 of the "Indian Medicine Central Council (Requirements of Minimum Standard for under-graduate Ayurveda Colleges and attached Hospitals) Regulations, 2016;
 - (ii) all the requirements of the Indian Medicine Central Council (Minimum Standards of Education in Indian Medicine) Amendment Regulations, 2016 (for Ayurveda); and
 - (iii) all the requirements under the provisions of the IMCC Act, 1970 and relevant Regulations made thereunder should be fulfilled *in toto*
 - (iv) all the requirements of the Indian Medicine Central Council (Post Graduate Ayurveda Education) Regulations, 2016 for grant of permission to PG courses.
- 8. The fulfillment of the conditions given above may be made within the time period specified and compliance report should be submitted by the college to CCIM under intimation to this Ministry. The CCIM will verify that the conditions have been fulfilled by means of an inspection and submit a report along with its assessment in this matter to the Ministry of AYUSH for considering the permission matter from the academic session 2020-21
- 9. The Ministry's order of even number dated 20/06/2019, stands suitably amended.

Sir/Madam,

I am directed to refer to the Ministry's order no. R.17011/110/2014-EP (IM-1) dated 02.09.2014 related to admission matter for a period not exceeding 5 years from the academic session 2014-15 to 2018-19, intimating that the college shall maintain all the Requirements of infrastructure and teaching & training facilities as per extant regulations *in toto* during the permission period (2014-15 to 2018-19). The Central Council shall visit the college *suo moto* three months before the expiry of permission to verify the requisite infrastructure and facilities required under above mentioned Regulations by means of an inspection and shall submit a report to the Ministry of AYUSH for considering the permission matter for the academic session 2019-20.

2. The CCIM had carried out an inspection of the institution on 15-16.03.2019 to reassess the available facilities of teaching and practical training as well as to verify the compliance submitted by the college and forwarded its recommendations and report to the Ministry. On examining the same, certain deficiencies have been observed and therefore, under provisions of the first proviso to sub-section (5) of Section 13A of the IMCC Act, 1970, an opportunity of hearing was granted to the college on 24.05.2019 to present the case.

- 3. The observations of hearing committee based on submission made representatives during hearing and recommendations & visitation report of the CCIM have been carefully examined in terms of Regulation 3 of the "Indian Medicine (Requirements of Minimum Standard for under-graduate Ayurveda Colleges and attached Hospitals) Regulations, 2016", IMCC Post Graduate Ayurveda Regulation 2016, provisions under the IMCC Act, 1970, relevant regulations made thereunder and as per approved Standard Operative Procedures (SOPs) and it is found that the College is fulfilling notified and approved criterion for granting Conditional Permission for UG (BAMS) course only.
- 3. It has, therefore, been decided by the Central Government to grant Conditional Permission to Rani Dullaiya Smriti Ayurved PG College and Hospital, Bhopal, Madhya Pradesh for conducting 100 seats in UG (BAMS) course and denial of permission for conducting 09 PG courses with 45 seats namely (i) Ayurved Samhita siddhant (ii) Rachana sharir (iii) Swasthavritta (iv) Kaumarabhritya (v) Agad Tantra (vi) Panchkarma (vii) Dravyaguna (viii) Rasashastra & Bhaishajya Kalpana (ix) Shalya Tantra with 05 seats in each subject for the academic session 2019-20 under Section 13C/13A of the IMCC Act, 1970 subject to the following conditions:
 - i. The college shall submit an undertaking in form of affidavit duly notarized within one month from the date of issue of this letter explaining the details of providing EPF and ESI facilities to the teaching, non-teaching staff of the Colleges/Hospitals and regularly paying the same as per the provisions of Employees' Provident Funds and Miscellaneous Provident Act, 1952 & ESI Act, 1948 and relevant Rules and Regulations.
 - ii. The colleges shall submit undertaking in the form of Affidavit duly notarized to get permanent registration of the Teachers/Hospital Clinical Staff/Consultant in concerned State Boards/Council where the college/hospital is located or Central Registration of the CCIM by 31st December, 2019 as per the decisions conveyed vide letters 22.03.2019 & 22.04.2019 by CCIM and decided by the High Court of Delhi in W.P. No. 2369 of 2019, which will be verified by the Council during next visitation while considering the matter for grant/denial of permission for the academic year 2020-21.
- 4. It is further informed that 15% of undergraduate of the permitted intake capacity of 100 UG seats shall be treated as all India quota. The counseling for seats under all India quotas shall be conducted by the Central Government and counseling for the remaining 85% seats shall be conducted by the concerned Counseling Authority of that State. If any seats are not filled up in the Central Counseling, the same shall be transferred to the said Counseling Authority to admit students as per their rules/ reservation policies/norms. The permission of the college stands withdrawn if the college fails to comply with the Central counseling for all India quota or the students admitted thereunder.
- 5. Admissions made in violation of the above conditions will be treated as invalid and action will be initiated under IMCC Act & Regulations made thereunder.
- 6. Discrepancies, if any, may be immediately brought to the notice of CCIM and the Central Government.
- 7. The following requirements should be fulfilled by the college by 31st December, 2019 to get permission for the session 2020-21:

- all the Requirements of Minimum Standard of infrastructure and teaching & training facilities as specified in Regulation 3 of the "Indian Medicine Central Council (Requirements of Minimum Standard for under-graduate Ayurveda Colleges and attached Hospitals) Regulations, 2016;
- all the requirements of the Indian Medicine Central Council (Minimum Standards of Education in Indian Medicine) Amendment Regulations, 2016 (for Ayurveda); and
- (iii) all the requirements under the provisions of the IMCC Act, 1970 and relevant Regulations made thereunder should be fulfilled in toto
- (iv) all the requirements of the Indian Medicine Central Council (Post Graduate Ayurveda Education) Regulations, 2016 for grant of permission to PG courses.
- The fulfillment of the conditions given above may be made within the time period specified 8. and compliance report should be submitted by the college to CCIM under intimation to this Ministry. The CCIM will verify that the conditions have been fulfilled by means of an inspection and submit a report along with its assessment in this matter to the Ministry of AYUSH for considering the permission matter from the academic session 2020-21.
